WHEN SHOULD I HAVE MY CHILD CHECKED FOR BRACES?

The American Association of Orthodontists recommends orthodontic screening at age 7 because most orthodontic problems can be detected at this age and proper treatment timing can be decided based on the findings.

WHAT ARE MY TREATMENT ALTERNATIVES?

We offer many treatment options including the traditional metal braces, clear braces, Invisalign® and Incognito Lingual Braces.

- Metal braces are very popular, efficient and stylish! A variety of color ties are available to make your smile even more vibrant.
- Clear braces are made of ceramic so they are translucent and barely visible.
- Lingual Incognito (hidden) braces are state of the art custom based braces that are placed "behind" your teeth making them truly invisible. They are especially fabricated and customized for your teeth to deliver the best treatment results!
- Clear aligner systems such as Invisalign® and Simpli5 allow straightening teeth without braces.



HOW LONG WILL MY ORTHODONTIC TREATMENT TAKE?

Treatment time depends on the procedure to be done and the complexity of the case and can range from a few months to 2 years. Few cases take more than 2 years to be finished.
